- Rain Gear

Gear will be inspected before Saturday's activities!

General Camporee Guidelines:

1. Unit Leader(s) must check-in their units at one of the registration times
2. Activity fees are non-refundable
3. Unit Leader(s) should accompany their unit through the day's activities.
4. If a Unit would like to assist with Flags (AM&PM), or assisting in judging the cooking competition, Please contact Camporee Staff
5. No vehicles are allowed to remain in campsites. Troop trailers ok.
6. Campfires allowed in above ground pits after 4pm
7. No water on site, available water close.
8. No pets or animals, service animals allowed.
9. No motor homes or camper trailers
10. No alcohol, firearms, bb guns, archery equipment.
11. All participants are required to provide a completed BSA Medical Form (Parts A & B) to be maintained by Unit Leader.

* It is NOT required that you stay overnight. You may come just for the day's activities, but the fee remains the same.
