Is your group in search of rugged outdoor adventure? Then dust off your boots and tackle the High Knoll Trail. After a shakedown and informational session conducted by one of our rangers, your crew will set out to hike a network of over 100 miles of trail crisscrossing the 16,000 acre Scout Reservation.

Though some crews shoot for the 50-Miler award, most hike around 6 to 8 miles each day before ending up at one of our backcountry camps. Outpost programs vary from year to year depending upon staff talents and demand. Your crew should plan to experience a mix of interpretive camps and modern high adventure programs offering a taste of Appalachian life, past and present.
